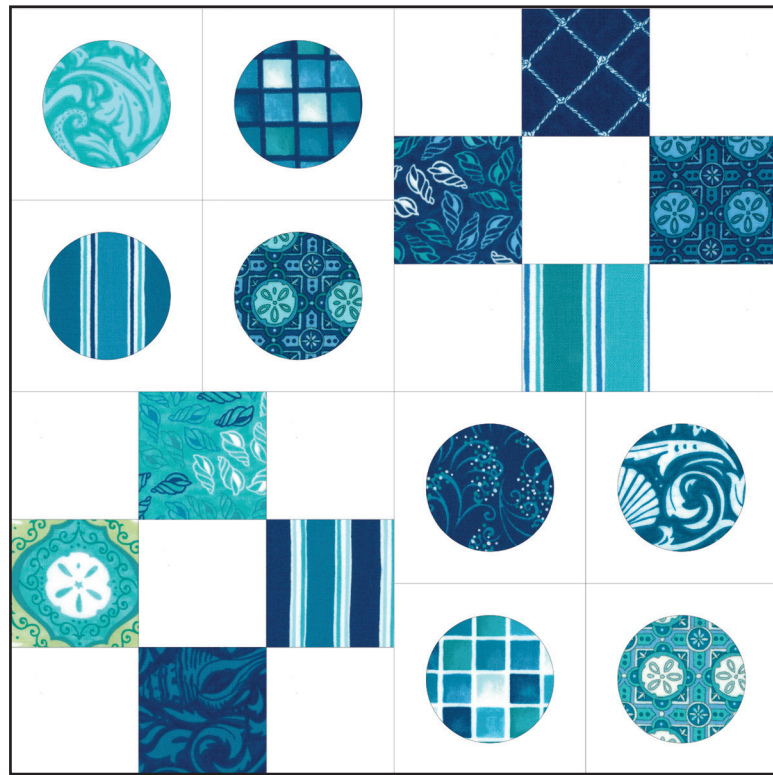


Sew Sweet Sampler Block 1



Block is 12" x 12".

Moda fabric:

SEASCAPES

Moda Candy:

16-2½" x 2½" squares

Background: (15" x 22")

2-2½" x 22" strips

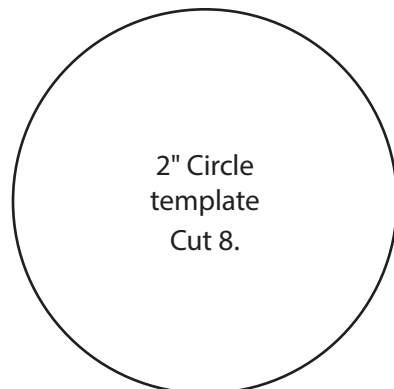
from 2 strips cut 10-2½" x 2½"

2-3½" x 22" strips

from 2 strips cut 8-3½" x 3½"

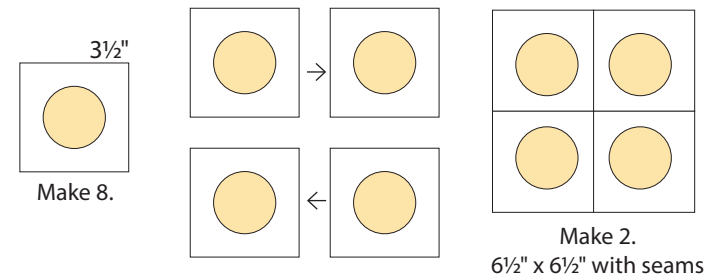

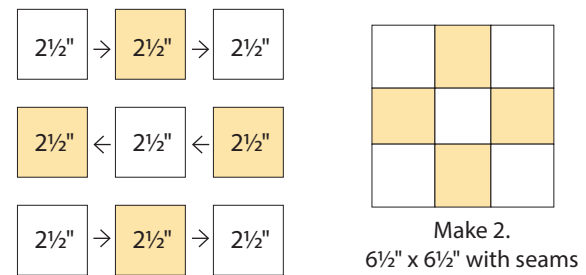

Block Construction

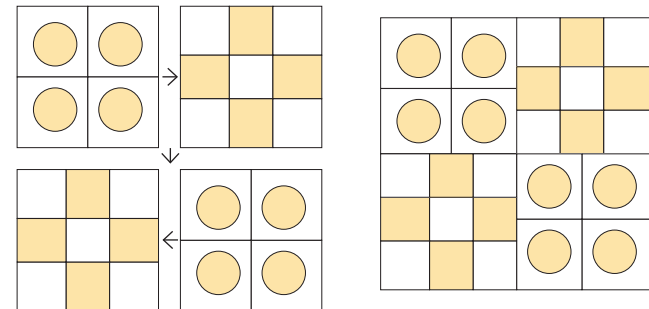
- Center and appliqué* the print circle to 1-3½" Background square. Make 8. Sew 4 squares together to make 1 block. Repeat.



- Combine 4-2½" print and 5-2½" Background squares as shown to make 1 block. Repeat.



- Arrange the units into rows. Sew the rows together. Combine the rows.



*Invisible machine appliqué:

Use Invisible Thread (100% clear nylon) with 0 tension on top, beige cotton thread on the bobbin spool, a quilting needle #90, and a very small zigzag stitch. As you zigzag make sure that the needle grabs the appliqué and the background fabric alternately. Zigzag around edge of appliqué with only one needle width onto appliqué.
