## Ingredients:



- 1 Frolic Layer Cake
- 1 Frolic Charm Pack
- 1/2 Yard Frolic Swirls Sky - Border
- 1 Yard Frolic Solids Bark - Border & Binding
- 1/4 Yard Frolic Swirls Wild Rose - Applique flowers
- 1/4 Yard Frolic Swirls Daffodil - Applique flowers
- 1/2 Yard Frolic Solids Tiger Lily - Applique flowers and words
- 4 Yards Cosmic Flowers - Backing

## Garnishes (optional):

- 2 Leather Button Round 2" Black
- 4 Leather Button Mum 2.25"

## Instructions:



Start out by cutting all of your layer cake squares in 1/2. As show in the image above.



After you cut the layer cake squares in 1/2 you will now cut the rectangles into angles. Start at the bottom corner and then line the ruler up 2" from the side, as show in the image above. Cut.

Repeat the process to make your blocks look like the shown block.

Now you will lay your blocks out like the image above.



To sew the blocks together you will sew into strips. First sew the angles to complete strips as show in the image shown.



Then you will sew the quilt top together in strips as show in the image shown.



Now take your charm charm pack. Using our starch applique tutorial you will cut circles from \*\*\*\*\* of your charm squares.

I used a CD for my template. Applique the circles to the centers of all the full blocks, except for the solid print blocks.



Now take your two fat quarters and your solid print. From those you will cut out the flower petals.

Applique the flower petals onto the solid print blocks.  
You will be making 2 - 1/2 blocks and 4 full flower blocks.



Now add circles to the centers of all of your flower blocks.  
As shown in the image below.



ADD BORDERS\*\*\*\*\*

Using your solid orange material you will now applique the words, Let your imagination bloom.
