**Moda Candy:**

- 25-2½" x 2½" Light/Medium squares
- 5-2½" x 2½" similar colors for Prairie Points
- 4-2½" x 2½" similar colors for Flower
- 5-2½" x 1¼" similar colors

**Button for Flower**

**Stuffing**

**Pillow Back & Flower Lining:** (1 Fat Quarter, 18" x 22")

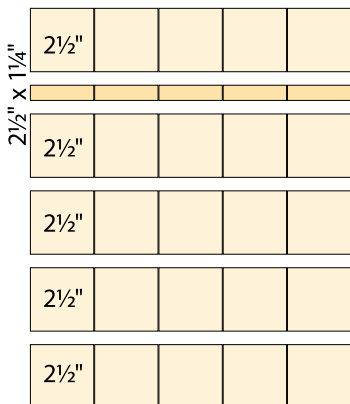
- 1-10½" x 11¼" rectangle
- 4-2½" x 2½" squares for Flower lining

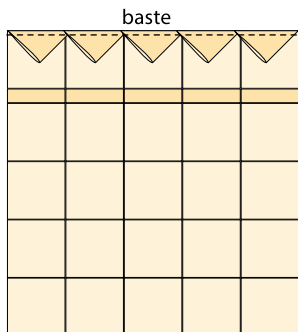
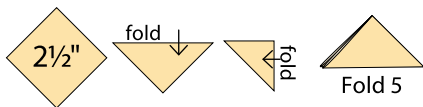

**1** Sew the 2½" squares and 2½" x 1¼" squares in rows as shown. Combine the rows.

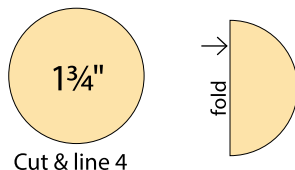


**2** **Prairie Points:** Fold 4-2½" squares as shown. Fold 5.

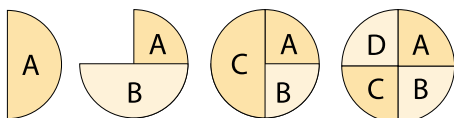
Pin the Prairie Points along the top of the quilt with points pointing in towards quilt. *Note the prairie points will overlap about ¼".* Baste Prairie Points in place.



**3** **Flower:** Trace the Circle template on the back of (4) 2½" squares. Layer a circle right sides together with a Lining square. Stitch on the traced line. Trim ⅛" from the sewn line. Cut a small slit in the lining only. Turn the flower right side out. Make 4. Fold the Circles in half, wrong sides together. Follow diagrams to make a flower, tacking each piece to the other and to the quilt as you go. Finish with the button.



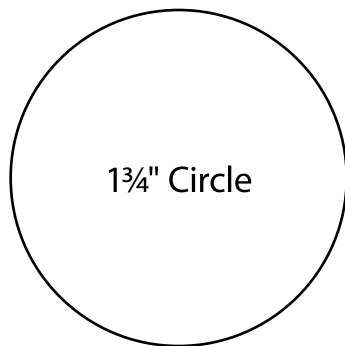
Cut & line 4



Tuck A under B.

B under C.

C under D.  
D under A.



**4** Layer the Pillow front and Back right sides together. Stitch, be sure to leave an opening for turning. Turn the pillow right side out. Stuff. Sew the opening closed.
