Main Print
31033-12
1⅝ yards



Sashing & Final border
Cream Solid or
Cream Linen
2¾ yards

Binding: ⅝ yard

Backing: 4 yards

Cutting:

MAIN PRINT:

Cut 10-5½" x WOF strips
set aside 8 strips
then subcut 8-5½" x 5½" squares

SASHING & FINAL BORDER:

Cut 1-70" x WOF
then 4-70" x 8½"
4-70" x 2"
then 4-51" x 2"
(sashing)

Cut 12-2" x WOF
set aside 8 strips
Combine 4 strips then cut|
3-2" x 51" (sashing)

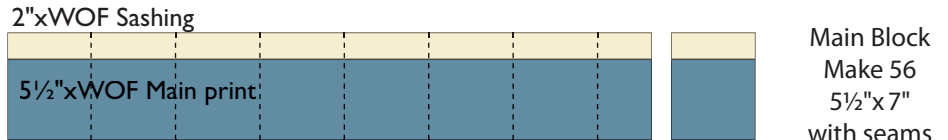
BINDING:

Cut 7-2½" x WOF

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- 1** Combine 1-5½" x WOF Main print strip and 1-2" x WOF sashing strip. Press away from the sashing. Make 8 strip sets. Cut into 56 Main blocks.



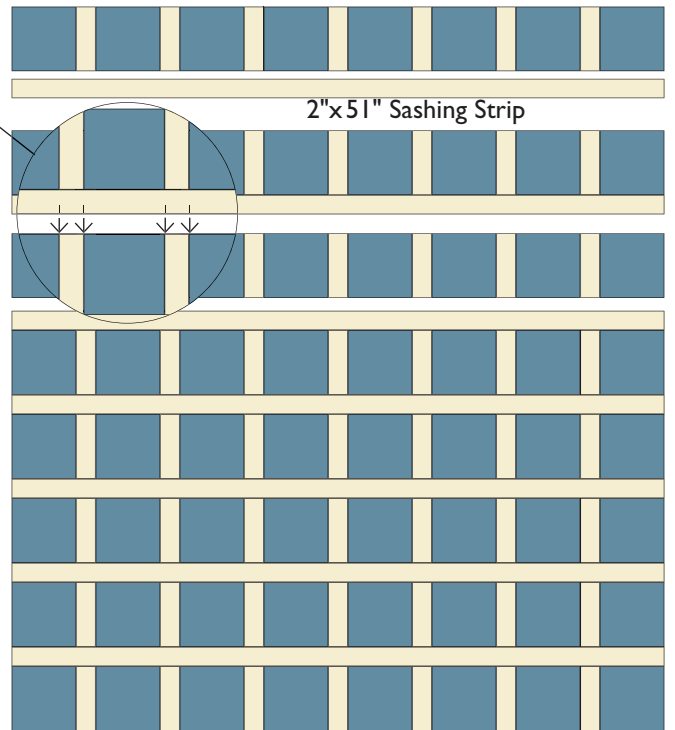
Make 8 strip sets. Cut into 5½" wide units.

- 2** Join 1-5½" x 5½" Main print square and 7 Main blocks to make a row. Press away from the sashing. Make 8 rows.

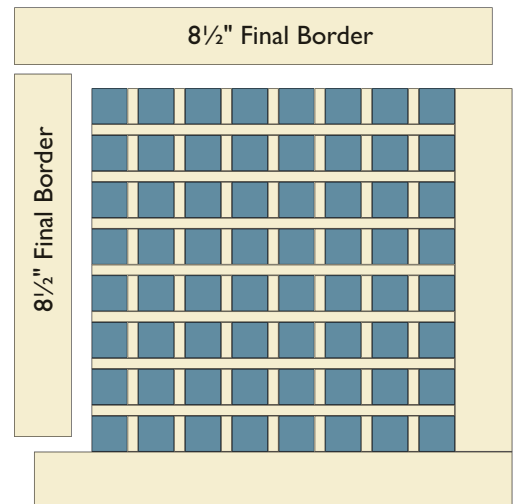


- 3** Sew the 8 rows and 7-2" x 51" sashing strips together. Press away from the rows.

Align a ruler with the edges of the row sashing. Mark the edge of the sashing strip opposite the sewn row seam. Use these marks to align the next row so the sashing aligns across the sashing strip.



- 4** Add the 8½" wide final borders sides first then top and bottom. Measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurement for the borders.



- 5** Layer, quilt, bind and ENJOY!
