CUTTING

Flowers:

- from EACH of the 4 half yards cut
 - 1-4½" x WOF strip
 - subcut 16-4½" x 2½" rectangles
 - 2-2½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 20-2½" x 2½" squares
 - 4-4½" x 2½" rectangles
 - 2-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 3-1½" x 22" strips

Flower red center:

- 3-2½" x 22"
 - subcut 20-2½" x 2½" squares

Flower yellow gingham center:

- 6-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 12-1½" x 22"

Nine patches (yellow):

- 6-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 11-1½" x 22"

Sashing & leaves (green stripe):

- 13-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 26-1½" x 22" for strip sets
- Cut 14 leaves from remainder

Nine patches, & leaves (green):

- from EACH of the 2 greens cut
 - 4-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 7-1½" x 22" for nine patch
- Cut 14 leaves from remainder-Total 28

Backgrounds:

- from EACH of the 2 backgrounds cut:
 - 1-4½" x WOF strip
 - subcut 16-4½" x 2½" rectangles
 - 9-2½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 120-2½" x 2½" squares
 - 4-4½" x 2½" rectangles
 - 11-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 21-1½" x 22" strips

Final border & binding:

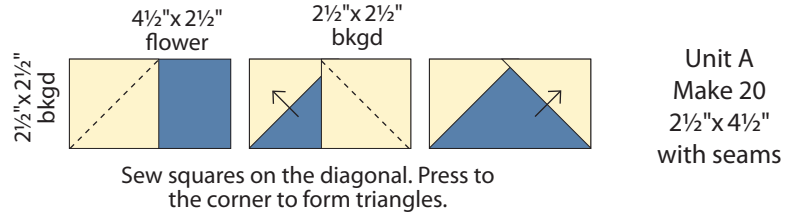
- 5-1½" x WOF strips
 - subcut 10-1½" x 22" strips
- 8-5½" x WOF strips for final border
- 8-2½" x WOF strips for binding

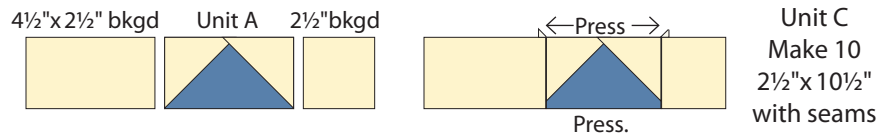
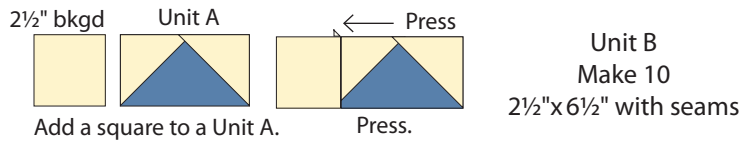
Construction

You will be making 5 flowers from **each** of the 4 prints. Two of the flower prints will have one background, the other two prints the second background. Repeat steps #1 through #4 to make a total of 20 flowers.

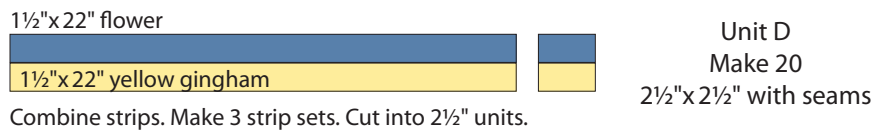
- Select one flower print and one background print to make 5 flowers. Sew 1-2½" x 2½" background square on the diagonal to 1-4½" x 2½" flower rectangle. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Sew 1-2½" x 2½" background square on the diagonal to the same flower rectangle. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Make 20 Unit As.



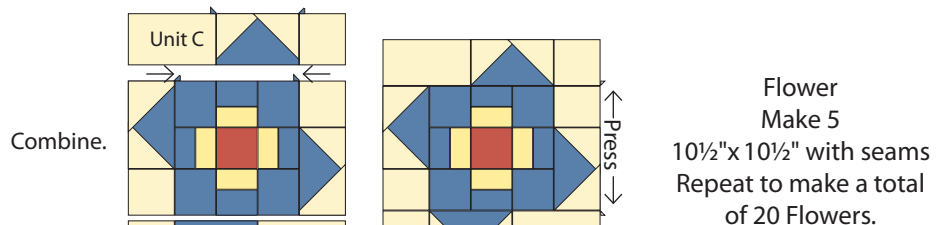
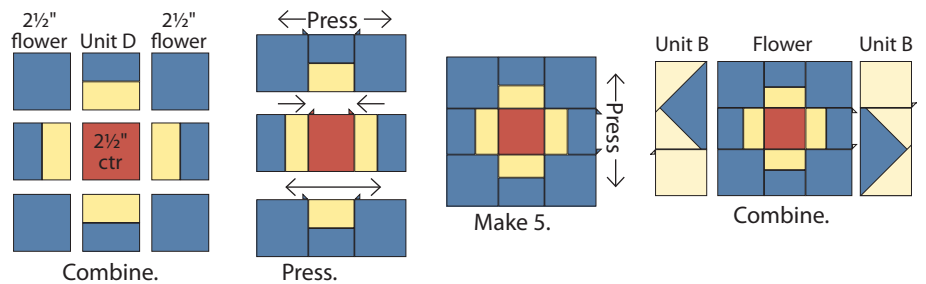
- Add 1-2½" x 2½" background square to left side of 1 Unit A to make a Unit B. Make 10. Add 1-4½" x 2½" (left) and 1-2½" x 2½" (right) background to 1 Unit A to make a Unit C. Make 10.



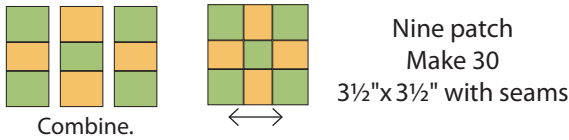
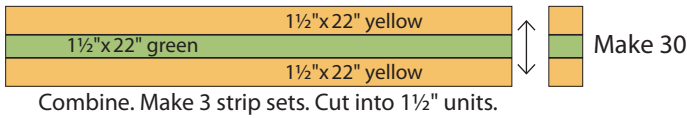
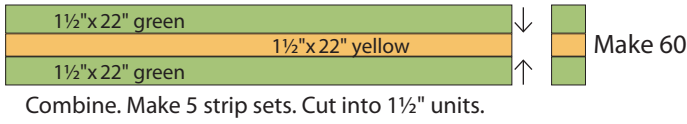
- Combine 1-1½" x 22" flower strip and 1-1½" x 22" yellow gingham strip. Make 3 strip sets. Cut into 2½" units. Make 20 Unit Ds.



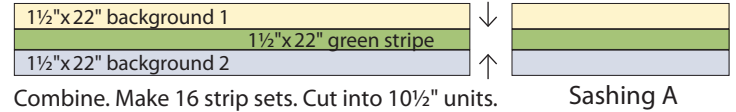
- Combine 1-2½" x 2½" flower red center, 4-2½" x 2½" flower prints and 4 Units Ds. See diagram. Press as shown. Make 5. Add 2 Unit Bs and 2 Units C. See diagram. Make 5 Flowers 10½" x 10½".



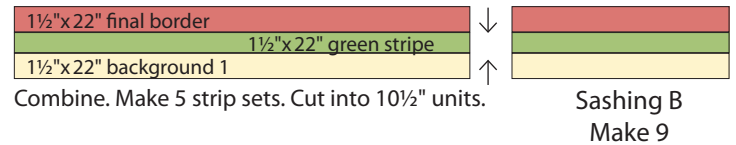
5 Nine patches. Combine 2–1½"x22" assorted green strips and 1–1½"x22" yellow strip. *See diagram.* Make 5 strip sets. Cut into 1½" units. Make 60. Combine 1–1½"x22" assorted green strip and 2–1½"x22" yellow strips. *See diagram.* Make 3 strip sets. Cut into 1½" units. Make 30. Combine to make 30 nine patches. *See diagram.*



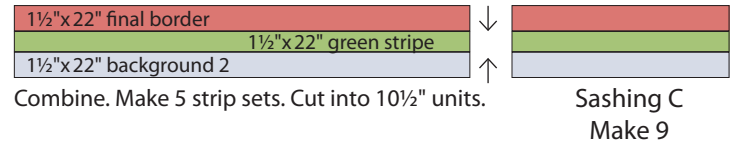
6 Sashing. Combine 1–1½"x22" background #1 strip, 1–1½"x22" green stripe strip and 1–1½"x22" background #2 strip. *See diagram.* Make 16 strip sets. Cut into 10½" units. Make 31 Sashing As.



7 Combine 1–1½"x22" final border strip, 1–1½"x22" green stripe strip and 1–1½"x22" background #1 strip. *See diagram.* Make 5 strip sets. Cut into 10½" units. Make 9 Sashing Bs.



8 Combine 1–1½"x22" final border strip, 1–1½"x22" green stripe strip and 1–1½"x22" background #2 strip. *See diagram.* Make 5 strip sets. Cut into 10½" units. Make 9 Sashing Cs.



Assemble Quilt

9 Use the following blocks to make the quilt top:

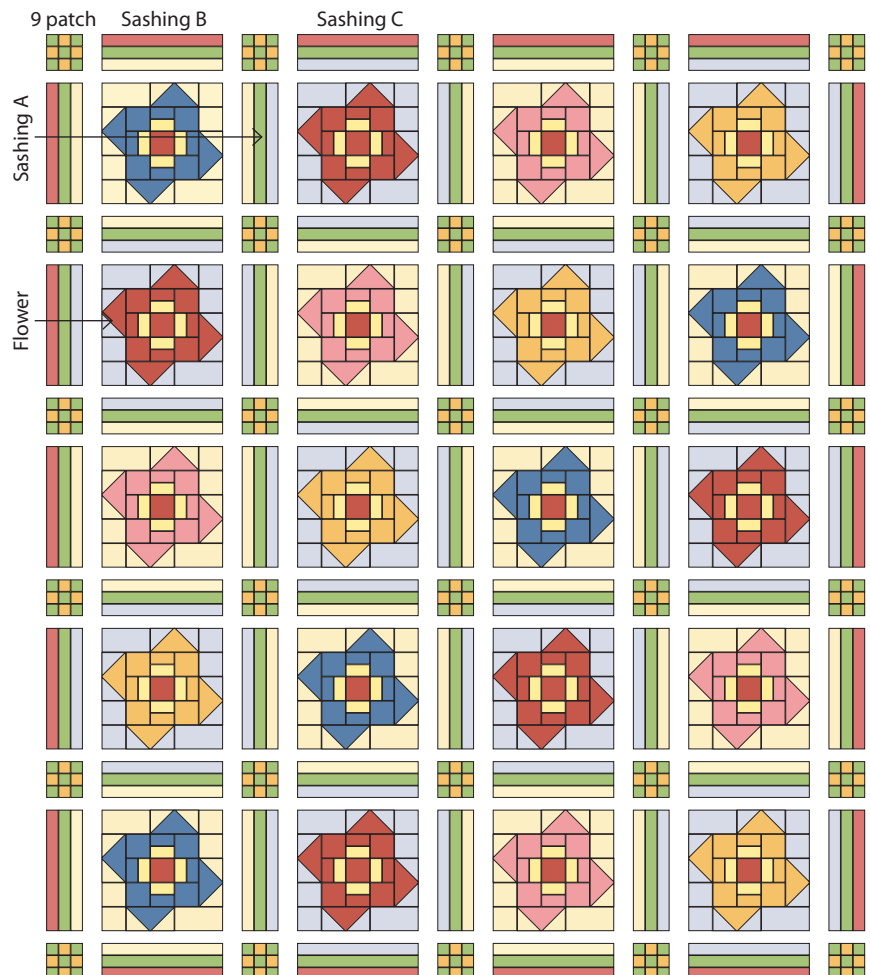
- 20 Flower blocks
- 30 Nine patch blocks
- 31 Sashing A
- 9 Sashing B
- 9 Sashing C

Sew rows together. *See diagram.* Press away from the nine patches and the flower blocks. Combine the rows.

Quilt top is now
55½"x68½"

Quilter Basics:

Read instructions before beginning a project.
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance.
Press as you go.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

- Flowers: 4 assorted prints 1/2 yard of each
(#18031-28, 18031-31, 18034-12, 18032-19)
- Flower Center - red: #18036-12 1 fat eighth (10"x22")
- Flower Center - yellow gingham: #18033-14 1/3 yd.
- Nine Patch - yellow: #18034-14 1/3 yd.
- Sashing & Leaves (green stripe): #18035-15 1 yd.
- Nine Patch & Leaves: 2 assorted greens 1/2 yd. EA
(#18034-15, 18036-15)
- Backgrounds: 2 assorted bkgds 1 1/2 yds. EA
(#18034-20, 18036-35)
- Final border & binding: #18033-12 2 1/8 yards
- Backing: 4 yards if pieced across

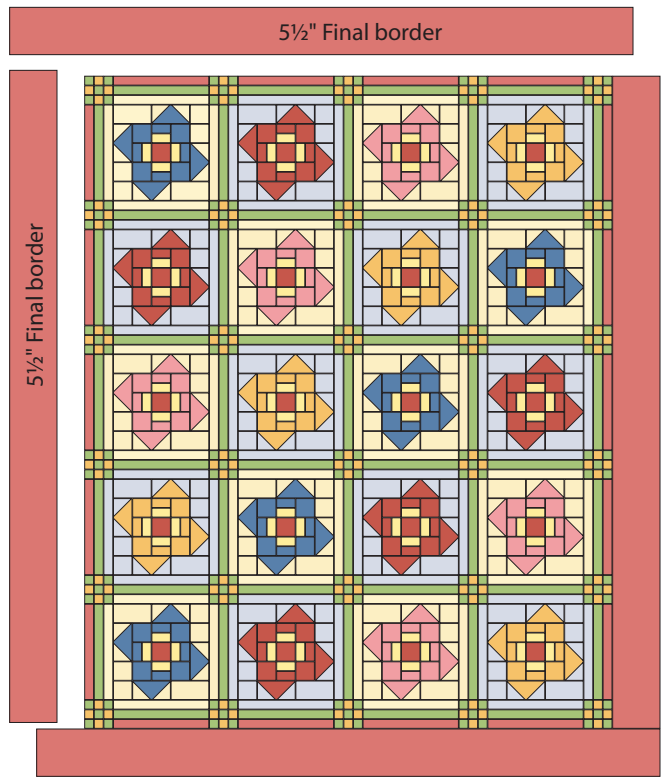

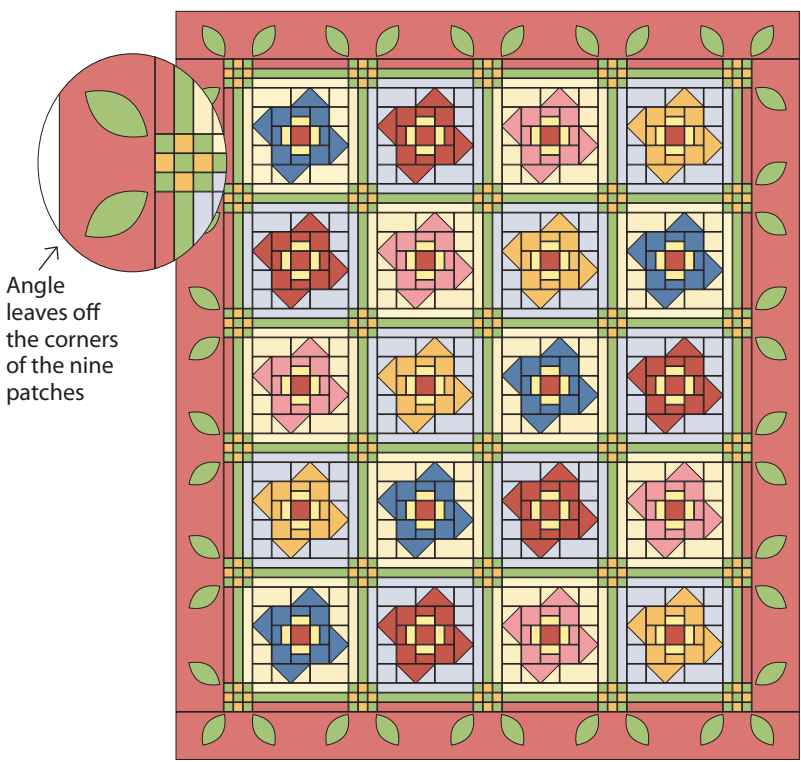

10 Join the 8-5 1/2"x WOF final border strips. Add the final borders to the sides first then top and bottom. *Before you add each border, measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurements for the length of the borders.*



11 Use your appliqué method of choice to add the 40 leaves to the quilt top. Angle the leaves off the corners of the nine patches. Join the 8-2 1/2"x WOF binding strips. Layer, quilt, bind and ENJOY!
