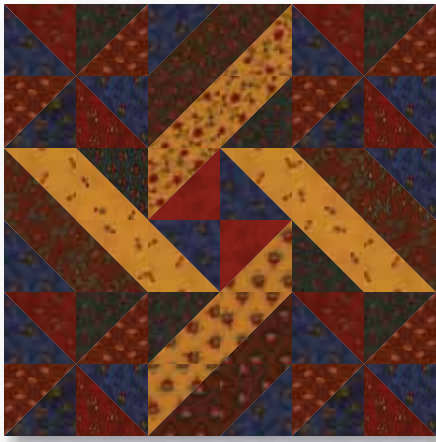
Featuring the Fabric Collection: Climbing Jacob's Ladder

"In 1935, quilt collector Carrie Hall recorded the name "Catch Me If You Can" for an old block, that has many other names including "Winding Blades", Devil's Puzzle", and "Flyfoot".

This pattern can remind us of the Underground Railroad when escaping slaves ran to freedom. Although the block's name is a twentieth century invention, the lively image seems to capture the cleverness such a journey required."

Red (R1)  18-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
8100-12 (36 total triangles)
1/4 yard


Red (R2)  16-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
8103-12 (32 total triangles)
1/4 yard


Red (R3)  6-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
8104-12 (12 total triangles)
1/3 yard 8-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
4-6 1/2" x 6 1/2"


Blue (B1)  12-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
8100-11 4-3 1/2" x 6 1/2"
3/8 yard 9-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
(17 total triangles)


Blue (B2)  16-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
8101-11 19-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
1/2 yard (38 total triangles)


Blue (B3)  4-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
8103-11 13-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
3/8 yard (25 total triangles)


Yellow (Y1)  48-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
8101-14 16-3 1/2" x 6 1/2"
1 yard 4-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
(8 total triangles)


Yellow (Y2)  8-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
8102-14 4-3 1/2" x 6 1/2"
1/2 yard 10-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
(20 total triangles)

Yellow (Y3)  8-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
8103-14 4-3 1/2" x 6 1/2"
1/2 yard 10-3 7/8" x 3 7/8" cut in half diagonally
(20 total triangles)

Brown (BR1)  8-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

QUILTERS BASICS:

Read instructions before beginning a project.

All instructions include 1/4" seam allowance.

WOF = width of fabric



Inner border: 8105-15
1/4 yard
5-1 1/2" x width of fabric



Final border: 8107-12
2 yards
4-8 1/2" cut 4 of the same
pattern the length of the
fabric

BINDING: 2/3 yard 7-2 1/2" x WOF

BACKING: 4 yards

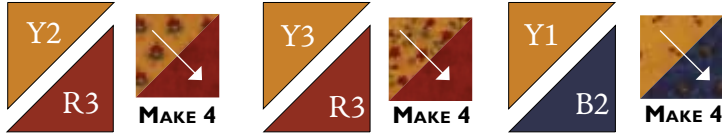
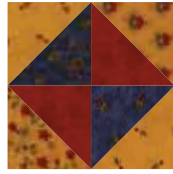
CONSTRUCTION

Large Block Center Block

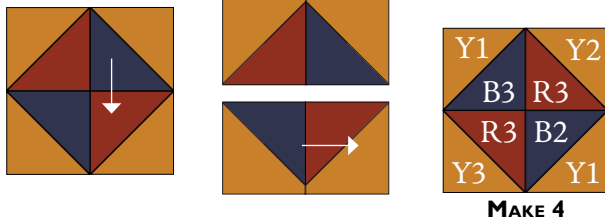
MAKE 4

1. Sew together $3\frac{7}{8}$ " red to yellow triangle and blue to yellow triangle as shown

Note the placement of the prints.



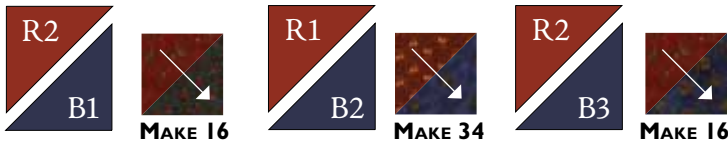
2. Assemble four blocks.



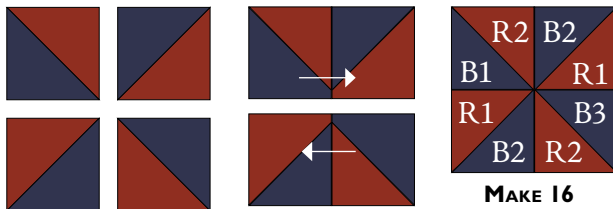
Pinwheel Blocks

1. Sew together $3\frac{7}{8}$ " red to blue triangles. Note the placement of the prints.



2. Assemble 16 pinwheels.



Quilt Center Block

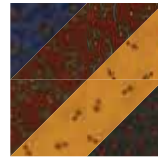

3. Rotate triangle units to make the sashing center block.

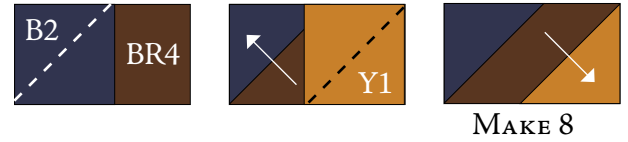
Spinning Blade Blocks

BLOCK 1 MAKE 8

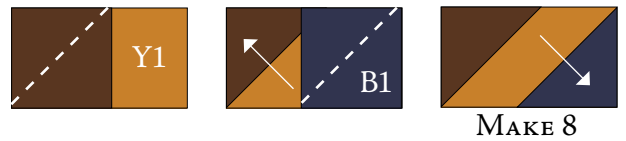


1. Using easy corner triangles sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue print and one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow print to the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " brown print.

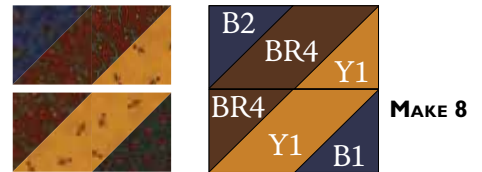
Note the fabric placement.



2. Using easy corner triangles sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue print and one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " brown print to the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow.

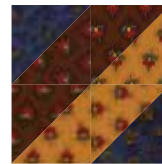


3. Assemble Block #1.

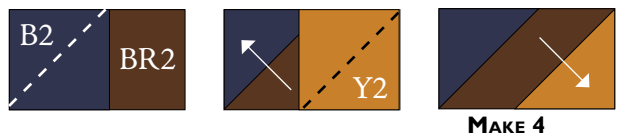

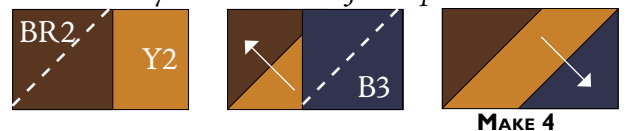

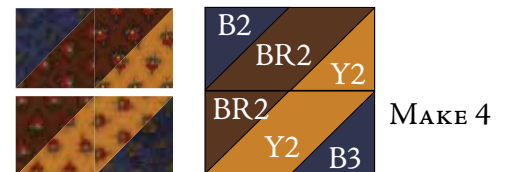
4. Using easy corner triangles sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue print and one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow print to the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " brown print. Note the fabric placement.



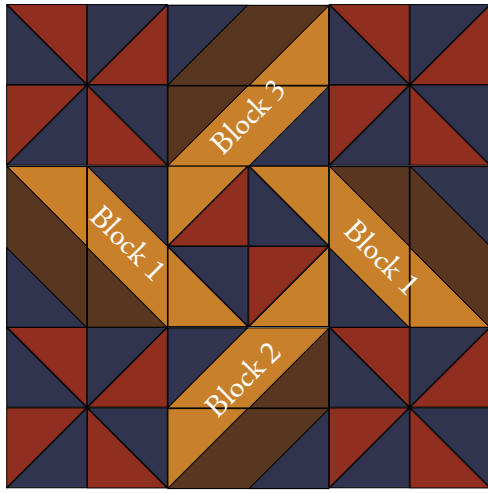
5. Using easy corner triangles sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " blue print and one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " brown print to the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow.



6. Assemble Block #2.



CONSTRUCTION — CONT.



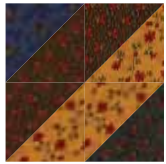
The quilt consists of four large blocks with spinning blades.

Rotate large block at left ¼ turn as you assemble quilt.

In EACH block there are 3 different print combinations. (2 of one combination) Four blades in total.

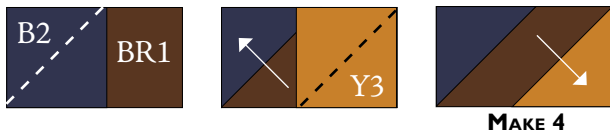
The blade tips extend into the center and outer sashing.

Center Sashing Blocks



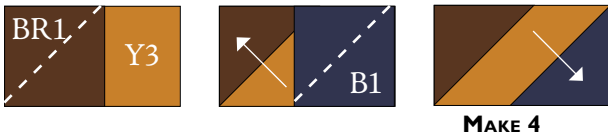

7. Using easy corner triangles sew one 3½" x 3½" blue print and one 3½" x 3½" yellow print to the 3½" x 6½" brown print. Note the fabric placement.

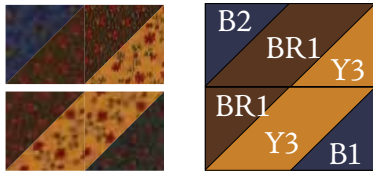

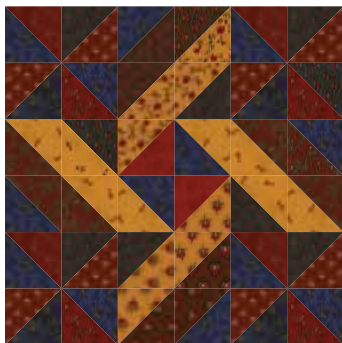
8. Using easy corner triangles sew one 3½" x 3½" blue print and one 3½" x 3½" brown print to the 3½" x 6½" yellow.

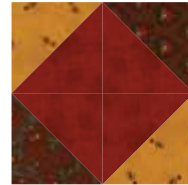
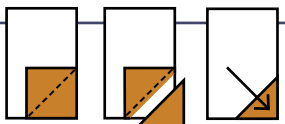
Refer to diagram above and assemble 4 large blocks. Blocks should measure 18½" x 18½"

Block should measure 18½" x 18½" unfinished.

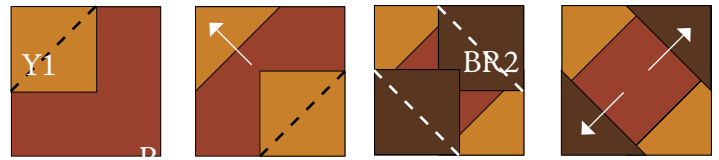
MAKING EASY CORNER TRIANGLES:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square.
Sew on the diagonal line.
Cut the square ¼" away from the diagonal seam.
Press towards to the corner to form the triangle.

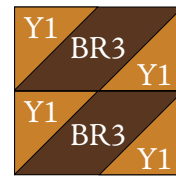
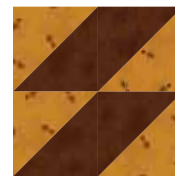


MAKE 4

1. Using easy corner triangles sew two 3½" x 3½" brown prints and two 3½" x 3½" yellow prints to the 6½" x 6½" red print. Note fabric placement.

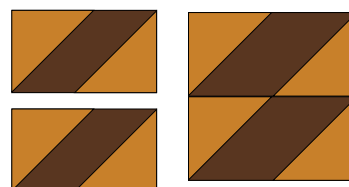
MAKE 8 Units

1. Using easy corner triangles, sew two 3½" x 3½" yellow prints to one 3½" x 6½" brown print. Make 16.

2. Assemble 8 units.

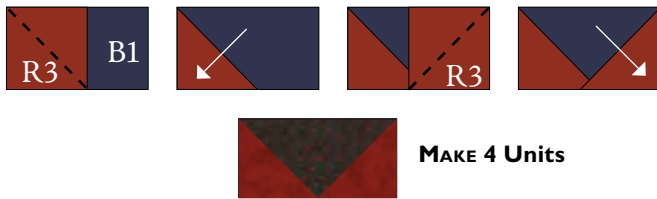

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Side Sashing Units

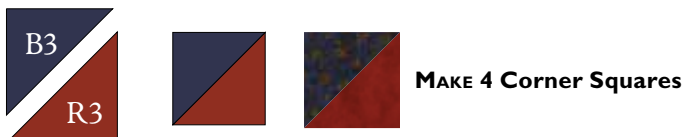
- Using easy corner triangles sew two $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " red prints to one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " blue print.



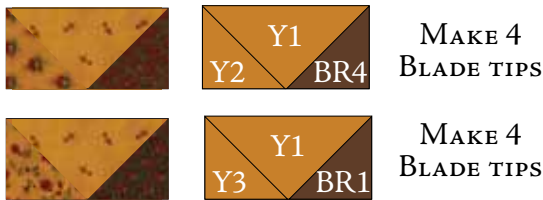
- Sew together one $3\frac{7}{8}$ " brown triangle to one $3\frac{7}{8}$ " yellow triangle.



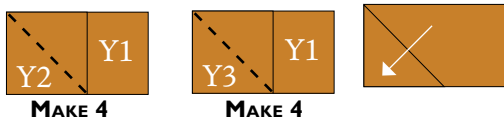
- Sew together one $3\frac{7}{8}$ " blue triangle and to one $3\frac{7}{8}$ " red triangle for corner squares.



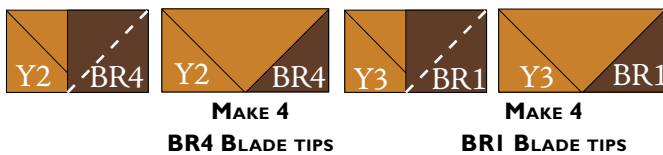
Side Sashing Blade Tips



- Using easy corner triangles sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow print to one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " yellow print. *Note the fabric placement.*



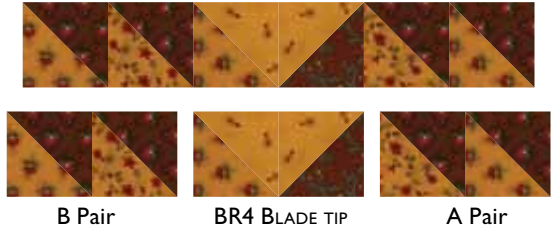
- Using easy corner triangles sew one $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " brown to the previous unit. *Note the fabric placement.*



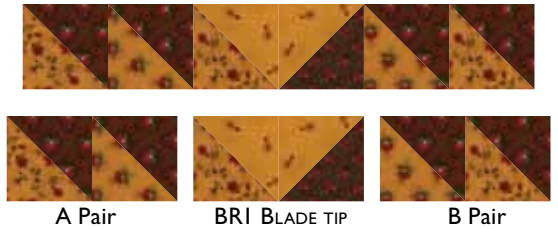
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ASSEMBLE SIDE SASHING UNITS

ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP

Refer to diagram below and layout various quilt units before assembling quilt. Be sure to match blade tip in the side and center sashing with the "blades" in large block. Sew blocks into Rows 1-5 and then join rows to complete quilt top. Quilt top should measure 48½" x 48½" before borders.

BORDERS

Each time you add a side border, measure the center of the quilt for the length of the border
Each time you add a top or bottom border, measure the center of the quilt for the length of the border.

Inner Border—Add the 1½" inner borders. Add the side borders then the top and bottom.

Final Border—Add the 8½" print final borders. Miter the corners.

FINISHING

Quilt as desired and bind.



Quilt Should Measure 66½" x 66½" unfinished.

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
