All instructions include seam allowance.
Please read instructions before beginning this project.

fabric

1 "Ghoul Friends" Panel – 10572-11

Stripe – 10573-11 3½ yards*

Black print– 10580-11 7/8 yard

Orange print– 10579-14..... ¼ yard

Black Solid..... 1/8 yard

Red Solid 1/8 yard

Backing..... 4 yards

Batting 61" x 61"

Binding..... ½ yard

*Note: Above yardage is required for repeat.

Cutting

FROM "GHOUL FRIENDS" PANEL, CUT:

✂ Center Witch scene, on the line defining the outside edge of the green rippled border.

✂ Each of 4 smaller rectangle single witch panels. Center each witch design and cut 7½" x 9½"

FROM BLACK PRINT, CUT:

🍷 2 strips, 4½" x WOF
Subcut: 2 strips, 4½" x 25" for **Border #3 sides**

🍷 3 strips, 6" x WOF
Piece and subcut: 2 strips, 6" x 45" for **Border #3 top and bottom**

FROM ORANGE PRINT, CUT:

✂ 3 strips, 2¼" x WOF
Piece and subcut: 2 strips 2¼" x 25" for **Border #1 sides and 2 strips, 2¼" x 32" for Border #1 top and sides**

✂ 1 strip, 1" x WOF
Piece and subcut: 2 strips 1" x 9½" and 2 strips 1" x 8½"

FROM RED SOLID, CUT:

✂ 1 strip, 1" x WOF
Subcut: 2 strips 1" x 9½" and 2 strips 1" x 8½"

FROM BLACK SOLID, CUT:

✂ 2 strip, 1" x WOF
Subcut: 4 strips 1" x 9½" and 4 strips 1" x 8½"

FROM STRIPE, CUT:

🍷 **Border #2** – 3" wide *see illustration on next page*
Piece and subcut: 2 strips, 3" x 29" for sides 2 strips, 3" x 38" for top and bottom

🍷 **Border #4** – 3½" wide *see illustration on next page*
Piece and subcut: 2 strips 3½" x 45" for sides 2 strips, 3½" x 51" for top and bottom

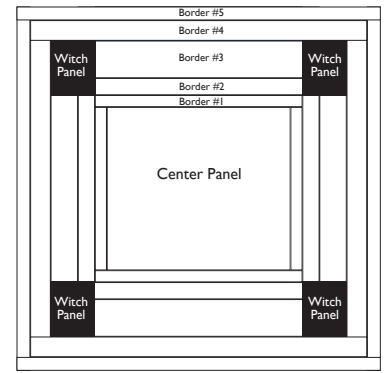
🍷 **Border #5** – 2½" wide *see illustration on next page*
Piece and subcut: 2 strips 2½" x 51" for sides 2 strips, 2½" x 56" for top and bottom

FROM BINDING FABRIC, CUT:

6 strips 2¼" x WOF

construction

1. Beginning with center witch scene, add each consecutive borders #1 - #5.
Join side borders first and then top and bottom. You will need to square quilt top after adding each border.
2. Prepare backing for the quilt to measure 61"x 61". From the left over fabric, cut 4 rectangles, 9"x11" to be used to "double face" single witch panel appliqués.
3. Add narrow border strips to each single witch panel. Sew sides first and then top and bottom. Two will be bordered in solid black and one in orange and one in red.
4. Place and pin each single witch panel centered on each 9"x11" rectangle from backing fabric. Pin right sides together. Stitch with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam around the entire panel. Trim backing fabric to panel size, clip corners, cut an "X" in the backing fabric only and turn panel right side out. Press. Repeat for all panels.
5. Place "double faced" panel in each corner of quilt top – refer to model. Hand appliqué or use machine stitch such as button hole or zigzag to finish.



finishing

1. Prepare the binding. Sew binding strips together, end to end. Press binding strips in half lengthwise with wrong sides together.
2. To quilt, layer and baste the quilt top, batting and backing. Quilt by machine or by hand. Apply the prepared binding
