## Fabric requirements:



Beige flowers  
5951-11  
1 yard  
final border



Green flowers  
5952-15  
1 yard  
sashing & binding



Beige leaves  
5953-11  
1 1/4 yards  
background, appliqué



Red check  
5954-12  
10"x22"  
birdhouse



Teal check  
5954-15  
10"x22"  
birdhouse



Red check  
5954-17  
10"x22"  
birdhouse



Red dots  
5955-20  
3/4 yard  
Roof, pole, base

Backing 3 1/2 yards

## Quilter Basics

*Read instructions before beginning a project.  
All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance.  
Press as you go. Press seams in one direction.*

## Cutting:

### Birdhouse:

from EACH of 3 prints:  
Cut 1-8"x22"  
then 3-8"x5 1/2"

### Roof, pole & base:

Cut 1-8 1/2"x WOF  
then 9-8 1/2"x 2"  
9-8 1/2"x 1 1/2"  
Cut 2-4 1/2"x WOF  
then 18-4 1/2"x 4 1/2"  
Cut 1-2"x WOF  
then 2-2"x 22"

### Final border:

Cut 5-5 1/2"x WOF

### Sashing & binding:

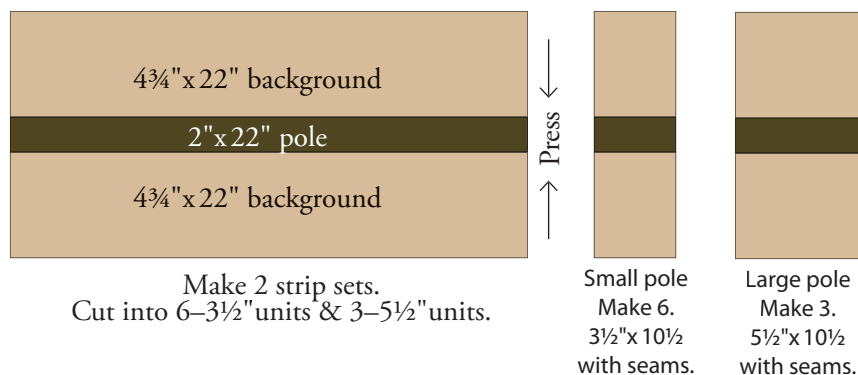
Cut 11-2 1/2"x WOF  
set aside 5 for binding  
then 4-2 1/2"x 4 1 1/2"  
2-2 1/2"x 3 8 1/2"

### Background:

Cut 1-10 1/2"x WOF  
then 18-10 1/2"x 1 1/2"  
Cut 1-8 x WOF  
then 18-8"x 2"  
Cut 2-4 3/4"x WOF  
then 4-4 3/4"x 22"  
Cut 2-4 1/2"x WOF  
then 18-4 1/2"x 4 1/2"

## Construction:

1 Join 2-4 3/4"x 22" background strips to 1-2"x 22" pole strip. Press away from the backgrounds. Make 2 strip sets. Cut 6-3 1/2"x 10 1/2" small poles and 3-5 1/2"x 10 1/2" large poles.

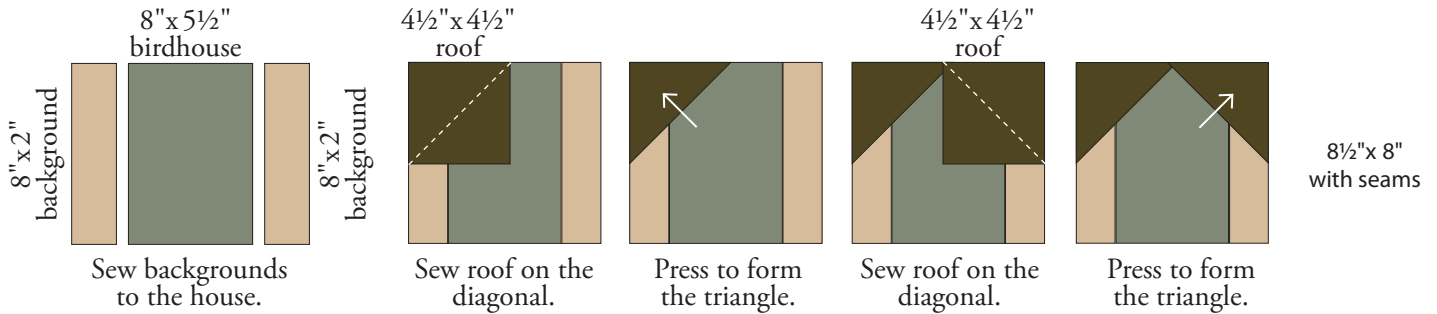

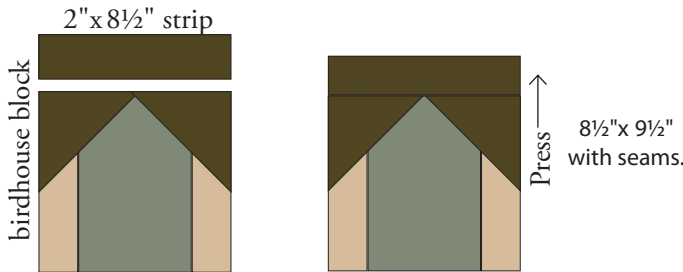
**Construction continued:**

*Repeat steps 1 thru 4 to make 9 birdhouse blocks.*

**2** Join 2-8"x2" backgrounds to 1-8"x5½" birdhouse. Draw a diagonal line of the back of 2-4½"x4½" roof squares. Layer the 2 roof squares and the birdhouse right sides together. See diagram for placement. Sew on the diagonal lines. Press to form the triangles.



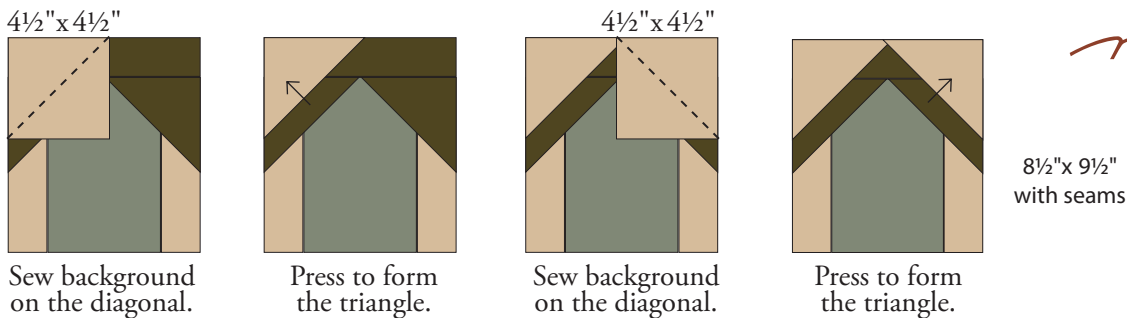
**3** Combine 1-2"x8½" roof rectangle to the birdhouse block.



Add roof rectangle to the birdhouse block.

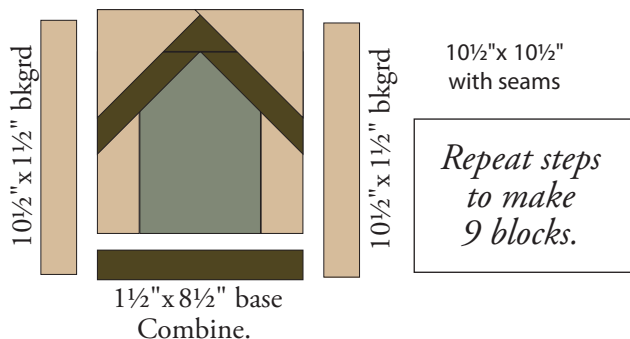


**4** Draw a diagonal line of the back of 2-4½"x4½" background squares. Layer the 2 background squares and the birdhouse block right sides together. See diagram for placement. Sew on the diagonal lines. Press to form the triangles.

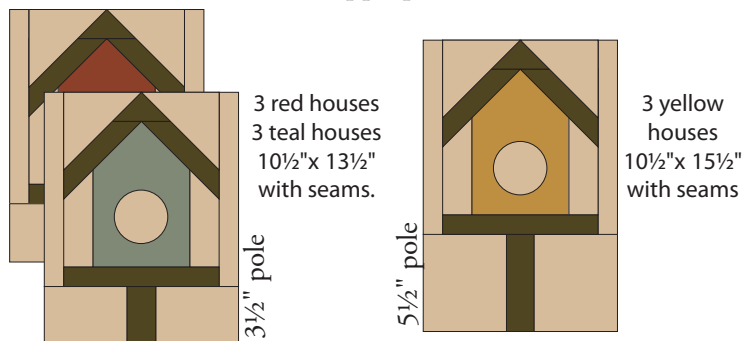

**5** Combine 1-1½"x8½" base and 2-10½"x1½" background rectangles to the birdhouse block. Press away from the house center.

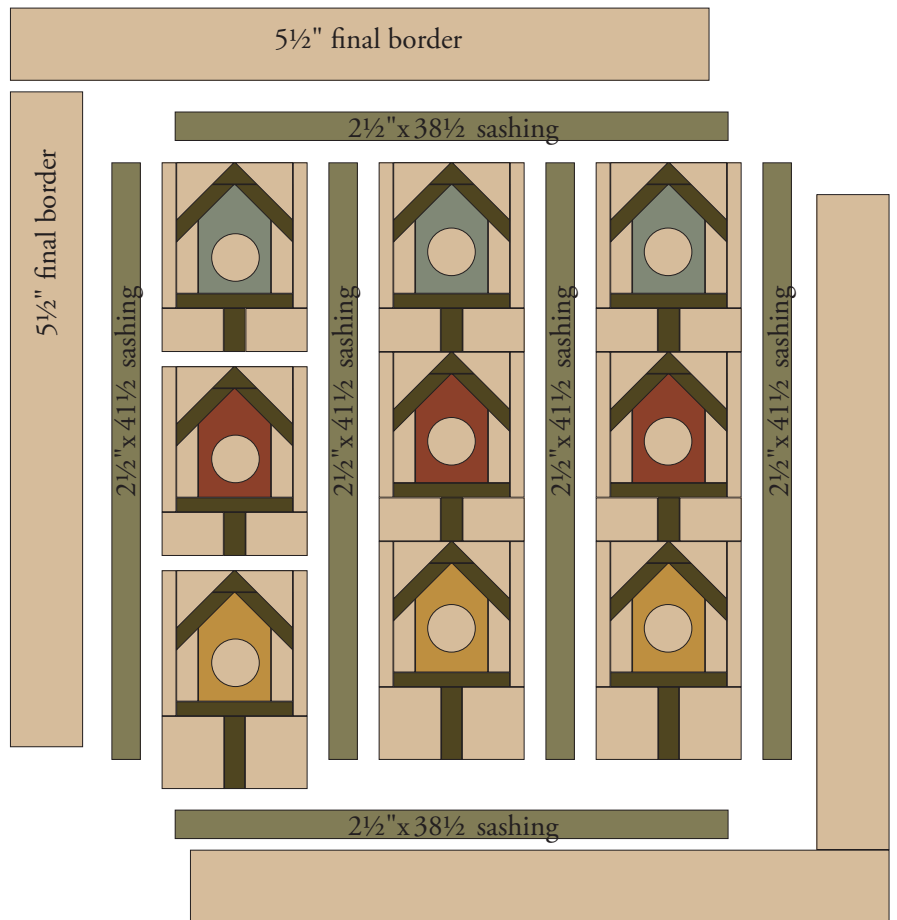


**6** Sew one 3½" pole to each of 3 teal and 3 red birdhouse blocks. Sew one 5½" pole to each of 3 yellow house blocks. Appliqué doors.



## Assembly:

- 7 Combine 3 birdhouses into 3 columns. Sew 4- $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $41\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strips and 3 birdhouse columns. See *diagram for placement*. Press away from the birdhouse columns.
- 8 Sew 2- $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $38\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strips to quilt to top and bottom. Press away from the quilt center.
- 9 Join the  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide final borders to the sides of the quilt. Measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurement for the length of the borders.
- 10 Join the  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " wide final borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurement for the length of the borders.



- 11 Layer, quilt and bind.
