Supplies & Cutting

Dark: (18" x 22")
8-2" x 22" strips

Medium: (9" x 22")
2-3 1/2" x 22" strips
cut the 2 strips into 8-3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares

Light: (12" x 22")
6-3/4" x 22" strips
use 4 strips for strip piecing
cut 2 strips into 8-3/4" x 3 3/4" strips
1-3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square

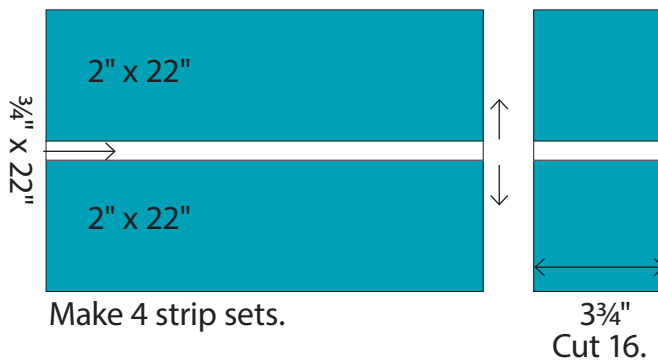
Invisible machine appliqué:

Use Invisible Thread (100% clear nylon) with 0 tension on top, beige cotton thread on the bobbin spool, a quilting needle #90, and a very small zigzag stitch. As you zigzag make sure that the needle grabs the appliqué and the background fabric alternately. Zigzag around edge of appliqué with only one needle width onto appliqué.

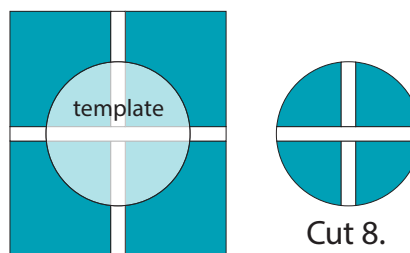
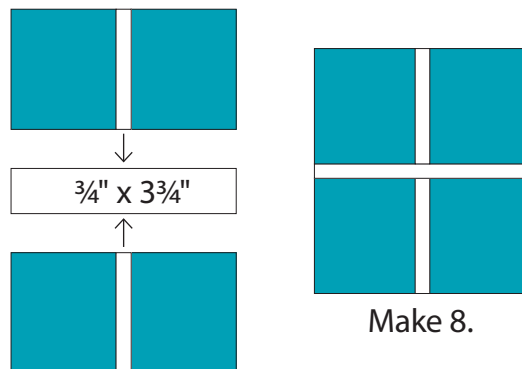
Use a 1/4" seam allowance.
Press in the direction of the arrows.

Quilt Construction

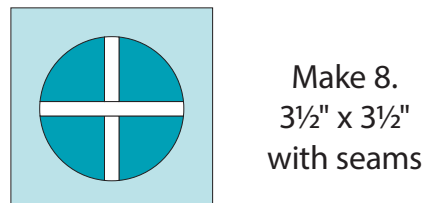
- 1 (A) Sew 1-3/4" x 22" Light and 2-2" x 22" Dark strips together as shown. Make 4 strip sets. Cut into 16-3 3/4" wide units.



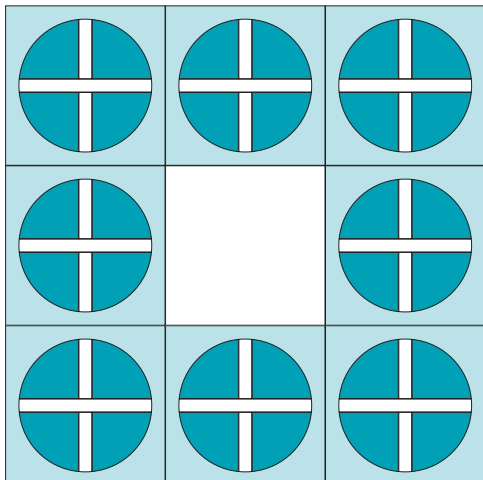
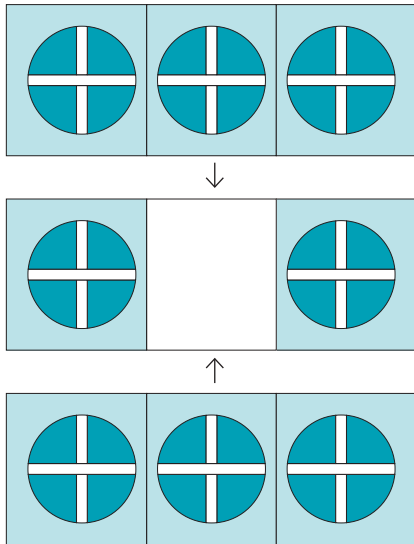
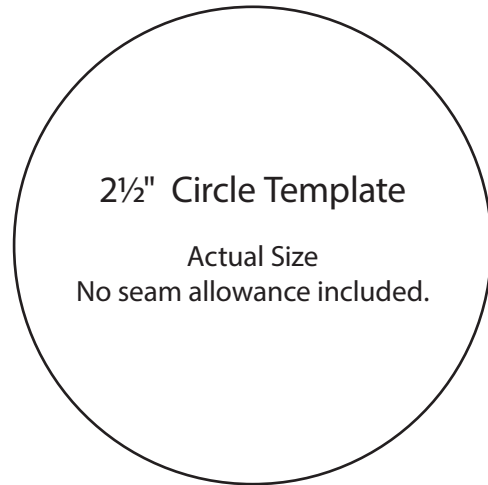
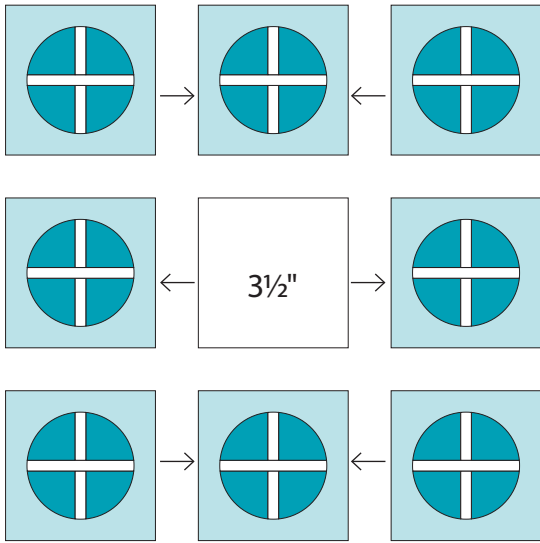
- (B) Join 1-1 3/4" x 3 3/4" Light rectangle with 2 of the previous units. Center and cut out the 2 1/2" Circle template from the block. Cut 8 Circles.



- (C) Center & appliqué each circle to 1-3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Medium square.



2 Assembly: Sew the block parts into rows as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows. Combine the rows.



9 1/2" x 9 1/2" with seams
