

## Block 15

### FIG TREE QUILTS

#### Supplies & Cutting

**Dark:** (9" x 11")

*cut carefully, you will be using 8" of the 9" wide strip*

4-2" x 11" strips

cut the 4 strips into 16-2" x 2" squares

**Medium:** (9" x 11")

2-3 1/2" x 11" strips

cut the 2 strips into 4-3 1/2" x 3 1/2" squares

**Light:** (9" x 22")

2-3 1/2" x 22" strips

cut the 2 strips into 8-3 1/2" x 2" rectangles

1-3 1/2" x 3 1/2" square

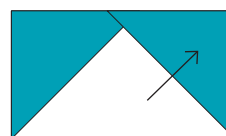
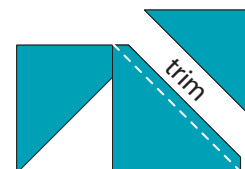
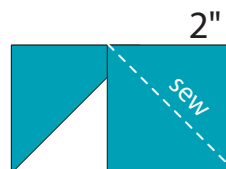
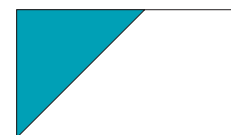
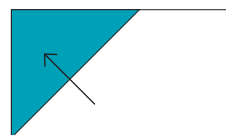
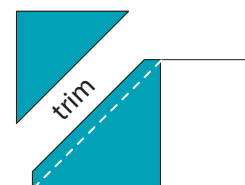
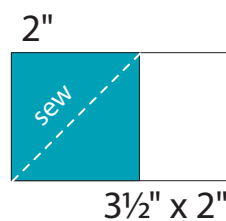
Use a 1/4" seam allowance.

Press in the direction of the arrows.

#### Quilt Construction

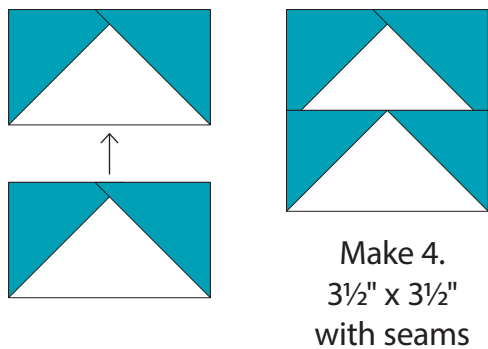
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 16-2" x 2" Dark squares.

**1** Layer, right sides together, 1-2" x 2" Dark square on 1-3 1/2" x 2" Light rectangle as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line. Press to the corner to form the triangle. Repeat on the opposite corner of the rectangle. Make 8.



Flying Geese  
Make 8.

2 Join 2 Flying Geese as shown. Make 4.



3 Assembly: Sew the block parts into rows as shown. Press in the direction of the arrows. Combine the rows.
